Three Eagle Trail Special Events Policy

The Three Eagle Trail is open to the public at all times for non-motorized pedestrian activities such as walking, biking, running and cross country skiing. Exceptions to this are electric mobility assistive devices and authorized maintenance vehicles. Also, snowmobiles are permitted on those portions of the Trail that are designated for snowmobile use during the snowmobile season.

Those using the Trail for a Special Event are responsible for ensuring that they do not interfere with the general public's use of the trail during the special event.

Natural and man-made hazards exist on the Trail. Wisconsin's Recreational Use Statute 895.52 applies to use of the Trail, which means that all users must use the Trail at their own risk.

The following Trail Rules apply to all users of the Trail:

Be courteous to others. Let them know of your approach in a clear and friendly manner.

Carry out what you carry in. Nobody likes litter on the Trail.

Respect private property by staying on the Trail.

Obey posted traffic signs.

Bicyclists must yield to pedestrians.

Feel free to take pictures and leave the plants, animals and natural features alone.
